Rule 896 of KPM is a new provision indicating responsibility of the Superintendent and Medical Officer, assuring the purity of water supplied to the Prison.

Rule 898 of KPM. The old rules 686, 687 have been combined with suitable modification and the periodical cleaning of wells and testing of depth to form the new rule.

Rule 899 of KPM. The old rules 688 and 689 have been combined to form the new rule.

Rule 900 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 693.

Rule 901 of KPM. The old rules 690 and 691 have been combined to form the new rule with suitable modification.

CHAPTER L

BURIAL OF THE DEAD

Rule 902 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 694.

Rule 903 of KPM is a new provision regarding the disposal of the dead body of a prisoner who dies from the hospital.

Rule 904 of KPM. This is a modified version of old rule 695, and is intended to cover the nature of disposal of the body of any prisoner dying in Prison or in local hospital or executed in Prison.

Rule 905 of KPM. This is a new provision laying down procedure on the performance of last rites.

Rule 906 of KPM is a new provision and is in accordance with the guidelines contained under Chapter LIV of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 907 of KPM is an enlarged version of old rule 696 and is based generally on Chapter LIV of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 908 of KPM is a new provision based on Chapter LIV of Model Prison Manual and is intended to lay down the procedure of intimating the death in certain cases.

Rule 909 of KPM is a new provision based on the guidelines given under Chapter LIV of Model Prison Manual. The old rule is silent on the expenditure to be incurred for the funeral/burial of prisoners.

Rule 910 of KPM is a new provision on the confession a prisoner desires to make when he is about to die in the case of Christian or for consolation if he is a non-Christian.

CHAPTER LI

PRISON GARDENS AND FARM

Rule 911 of KPM. The old rule 697 and 699 have been combined with modifications to form the new rule.

Rule 912 of KPM refers to the old rule 698, 700, 701 with additional information to explain fully about the maintenance of Prison gardens.

Rule 913 of KPM is a new provision about the care in gardening and use of implements.

Rule 914 of KPM. This is a new provision regarding the employment of prisoners in the Prison gardens.

Rule 915 of KPM. This is a new provision on the disposal of surplus vegetables after meeting the prison requirements.

Rule 916 of KPM is a new provision regarding the removal of trees from the Prison land.

Rule 917 of KPM is a new provision on the maintenance of garden and plot register.

Rule 918 of KPM is also new provision on the maintenance of lives-stock in the Prison.

Rule 919 of KPM is a modified form of old rule 702.

Rule 920 of KPM is a new provision on the scale of ration for the cattle.

Rule 921 of KPM is a new provision on keeping of animals by the staff.

Rule 922 of KPM is a new provision on the responsibility of Officers in storing of crops.

Rule 923 of KPM is a new provision regarding the storage of seeds.

Rule 924 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 703.

CHAPTER LII

PROVISIONS

Rule 925 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 704.

Rule 926 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 705.

Rule 927 of KPM covers the old rule 706. The new rule also amplifies the old rule.

Rule 928 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 707.

Rule 929 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 708.

Rule 931 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 710.

CHAPTER LIV

UNDER-TRIAL PRISONERS

Rule 960 of KPM is a reproduction of old rules 734 and 734A. See also G. O. MS. 172/69/Home dated 31-5-1969.

Rule 961 of KPM. The old rule 733 has been modified in conformity with the guidelines under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 962 of KPM is a new provision detailing the procedure of admission of under-trial prisoners. This is based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 963 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 741 with the difference that the last sentence of old rule has been deleted.

Rule 964 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 742.

Rule 965 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 743.

Rule 966 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 737.

Rule 967 of KPM. This is a new provision detailing the facilities that are to be extended to all under-trial prisoners. This is in accordance with the guidelines given under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 968 of KPM. The old rule 735 has been elaborated in accordance with the provisions contained under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual, to form the new rule.

Rule 969 of KPM. The first para of the old rule 736 has been reproduced here. The second para of the old rule 736 has been brought under a separate provision.

Rule 970 of KPM. As pointed out above the second para of old rule 736 has been extracted to form the new rule.

Rule 971 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 738. vested interests.

Rule 972 of KPM. The old rule 739 has been elaborated keeping in view the educational and recreational needs of under-trial prisoners.

Rule 973 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 740.

Rule 974 of KPM. The old rule 750 has been modified in respect of interview facilities and to be in conformity with the general principles given under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 975 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 751 and is in accordance with Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 976 of KPM. This is a new provision regarding the production of under-trial prisoners in a session case.

Rule 977 of KPM. This is an enlarged form of old rule 744.

Rule 978 of KPM. This is a new provision regarding the procedure on hand-cuffing of under trial prisoners. This new provision is based on Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 979 of KPM. This is a new provision in accordance with the guidelines given under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual. This rule gives the instructions for the Officers in charge of Police escort of under-trial prisoners, while on the court premises.

Rule 980 of KPM. This is a new provision on the lines given under Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 981 of KPM. This is a new provision narrating the type of articles an under-trial prisoner can be allowed to take with him while going to the court. This new provision is based on Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 982 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 747.

Rule 983 of KPM. This is a new provision and is based on Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 984 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 745.

Rule 985 of KPM. This is a new provision concerning the procedure of return to the Prison of an under-trial prisoner from the Court. This is based on Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 986 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 748.

Rule 987 of KPM. While retaining the old rule 749, additions have been made in accordance with Chapter XXXIX of Model Prison Manual.
